



## **Albert Einstein College of Medicine Weapons Policy**

**The possession of any weapon (as defined in local, state and federal statutes, and includes, without limitation, firearms, knives and explosives) on any College campus is strictly prohibited. This prohibition applies to all facilities owned, leased or otherwise controlled by the College, and whether academic, residential or otherwise. Failure to comply with this Policy may result in disciplinary action by the College (up to and including, in the case of a student, suspension or expulsion and, in the case of an employee, termination of employment) and also may result in criminal prosecution. In addition, the College reserves the right to confiscate the weapon. This policy applies to all members of the College community as well as visitors and guests, and regardless of whether the possessor is licensed to carry that weapon.**

**Exceptions to this Policy may only be made by the applicant requesting permission to the Chief of Security who will confer with the Associate Dean for Finance and Administration in consultation with the Executive Dean.**
