To date, all single-occupancy restrooms located in common, accessible areas at Einstein have been designated as gender-neutral restrooms. This is a first step as we work toward establishing gender-neutral restrooms in all buildings on campus. Where currently designated, proper signage has been installed for each of these restrooms.
