## Satisfactory Academic Progress Policy

### I. Purpose

This Policy describes requirements concerning financial aid and academic standing at Albert Einstein College of Medicine (“Einstein” or “College”).

### II. Scope

This Policy applies to all students of Einstein.

### III. Policy

To be eligible for financial aid from sources other than private or school-funded sources (emergency loans, grants, or scholarships provided solely at the discretion of the institution), a student must meet his or her school’s (Graduate Division or the College of Medicine) criteria for good academic standing. Based on regulations promulgated by various federal and state agencies, a recipient of financial aid from those sources may be allowed only one academic year of financial assistance while enrolled under probationary status. If a student is unable to achieve good academic standing at the end of the probationary semester, he or she will be dropped from eligibility for further financial aid until good academic standing is achieved.


